




2. Functional and Technical Requirements

2.1 General Requirements

- 2.1.1** Wireless USA will comply and provide and install two way radio antennas, Coax cable, coax cable connectors with a protective coating, a battery Backup power supply, and system testing for the Missouri Department of Corrections.



ARTICLE I

PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the points of agreement between the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and WirelessUSA, Inc.
